

## Assessment: Basic materials

This assessment is about using basic materials for a BCATS project.

You need to show you:

- have a solid understanding of materials that can be used for BCATS projects
- can use materials safely and skilfully for your project.

## Worksheet: Identify materials

For this assessment activity, you need to show you have a solid understanding of a range of materials that can be used for BCATS projects. It is an open book activity.

In the table below:



- list timber types and other materials that are appropriate to use in BCATS projects. **(Note: you must include the timber and other materials you will be using for your project in your list.)**
- explain how material could be used for BCATS projects, and why.

An example answer has been given.

Material	How the material could be used for BCATS projects, and why
Example:	
Glass	Glass could be used in a picture frame or as a window in a kitchen cabinet. It is useful because you can see into the cabinet without having to open the door.

## Use materials

You need to show you can do these things safely for your entire project without being prompted:

- Consider features of the timber and other materials when you are handling them (e.g. treated timber, rust-resistant hardware)
- Use the timber and other materials carefully and correctly
- Store the materials you've used for your project without damaging them.



Your teacher will observe you using the materials while you are working on your project.

Below is a guide to the other evidence you need to collect during your practical work. You should work with your teacher to make sure you've provided everything needed:



Photos of you handling and using the materials safely and skilfully when you are creating the project (e.g. using appropriate tools and cutting techniques for the type of timber) (if needed).

Photos of your neatly stored materials after you've used them.
