

Carry out construction processes

Project reflection – What were your strengths?

Example

I was really happy with the measuring and cutting I did for the storage box components. They fit together really well with no gaps. I also took my time with the sanding so when I applied the stain, it brought out the grain of the wood really nicely. I'm really happy with how the box looks!

Project reflection – What could you improve?

Example

I had to rush a bit at the end because of how long I spent sanding, so next time I'd leave more time for this step. My workspace got a bit messy so I need to work on putting my tools away when I've finished using them.
