Level 2: Project templates

Project record and reflection (examples)

A project record is a way of preparing for and carefully monitoring the progress of a project.

A project reflection allows you to think critically about your work when you have completed the project.

The example below lists: project tasks required for each stage of the project, quality checks carried out to make sure the finished project is durable and visually pleasing, feedback received, and improvements made as a result of the checks and feedback. This is followed by a reflection on how successful the project was and improvements that could be made for future projects.

Example: <i>Marking the timber</i>	<i>Confirmed measurements were accurate before cutting the timber.</i>	<i>My teacher said my pencil should be sharper so I could get more accurate measurements.</i>	<i>Made sure my pencil was sharpened before I did any more measurements.</i>

I had to rush a bit at the end because of how long I spent sanding, so next time I'd leave more time for this step in the process. My workplace got a bit messy at times, so I need to work on putting my tools away when I've finished using them.
