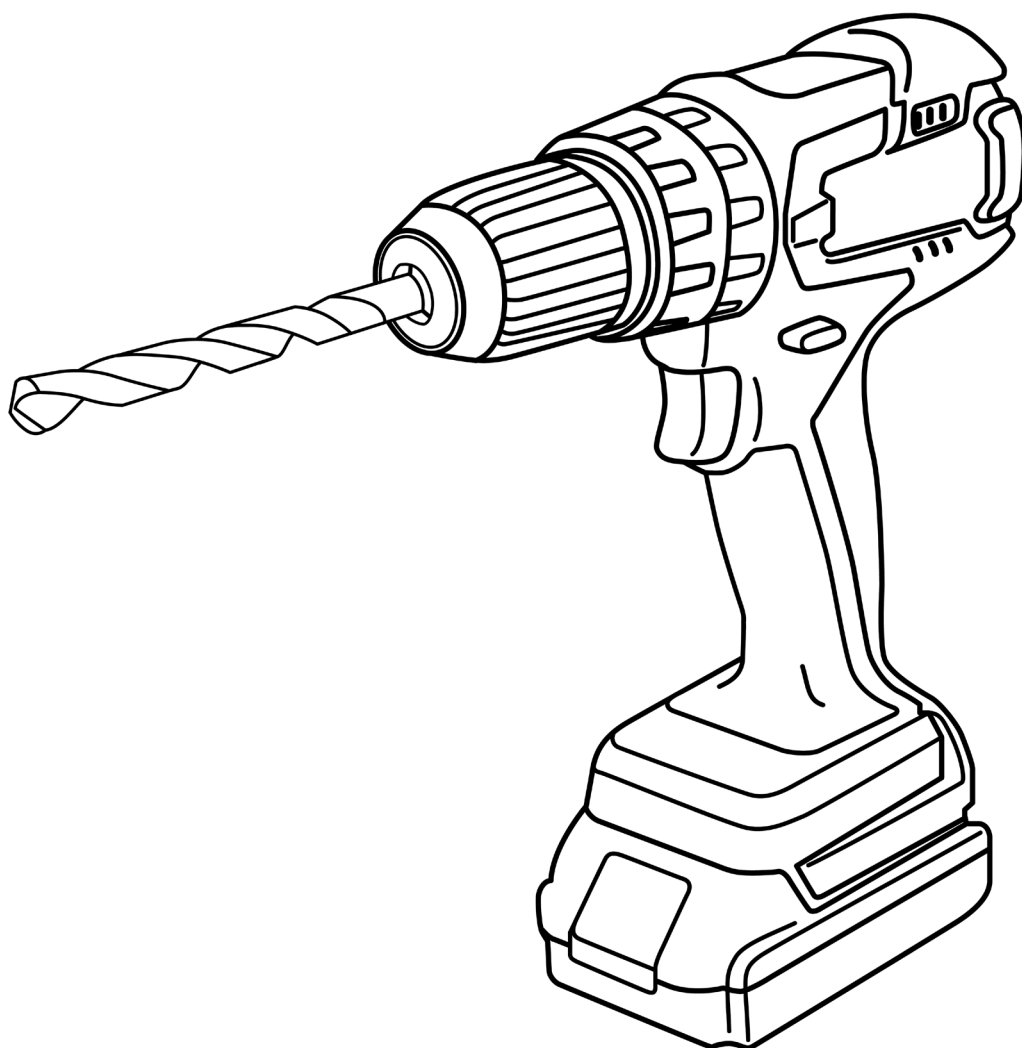

You need to show you can do these things without being prompted:

- Choose the best basic power tools for different project tasks.
- Set up and use basic power tools safely and skilfully for project tasks.
- Care for basic power tools after use.

You will need to provide the following evidence to support this. Submit it using myBCITO or the process at your school/organisation.

Record of cleaning and checks you completed for the tools you used (based on the process at your school/organisation).



Photos that clearly show you using power tools for different project tasks, and the PPE you wore when you were using them (if needed).

Worksheet: Identify basic power tools

For this assessment activity, you need to identify ideal basic power tools that you would use for BCATS project tasks. It is an open book activity.

Being able to choose the right tools is an important skill in the BCATS workplace.

In the table below:



- choose the best basic power tool for each of the tasks listed
- explain why you chose each tool.

An example answer has been given.

Project task	Tool	Reason for choosing the tool
Example: Stripping paint from re-purposed timber.	<i>Heat gun</i>	<i>The heat gun softens the paint and makes it blister and flake off the timber.</i>
Making pilot holes into timber.		
Cutting a curved shape out of a timber panel.		
Preparing a timber desktop for staining.		
Fixing decking timber with 65mm screws.		
Cleaning up dust and debris.		

Use basic power tools

- Choose the best basic power tools for your project tasks.
- Use appropriate PPE for the power tools you chose.
- Set up the power tools according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Use the power tools safely and skilfully to complete project tasks.

Photos that clearly show you using the basic power tools for different project tasks, and the PPE you wore when you were using them (if needed).

Care for basic power tools

You need to show you can do these things for your project without being prompted.

- Disconnect the power tools from power sources after use.
- Clean the tools you used thoroughly and check to make sure there are no issues
- Safely store the basic power tools well clear of power sources between uses.



Your teacher will observe you caring for the basic power tools while you are working on your project.
