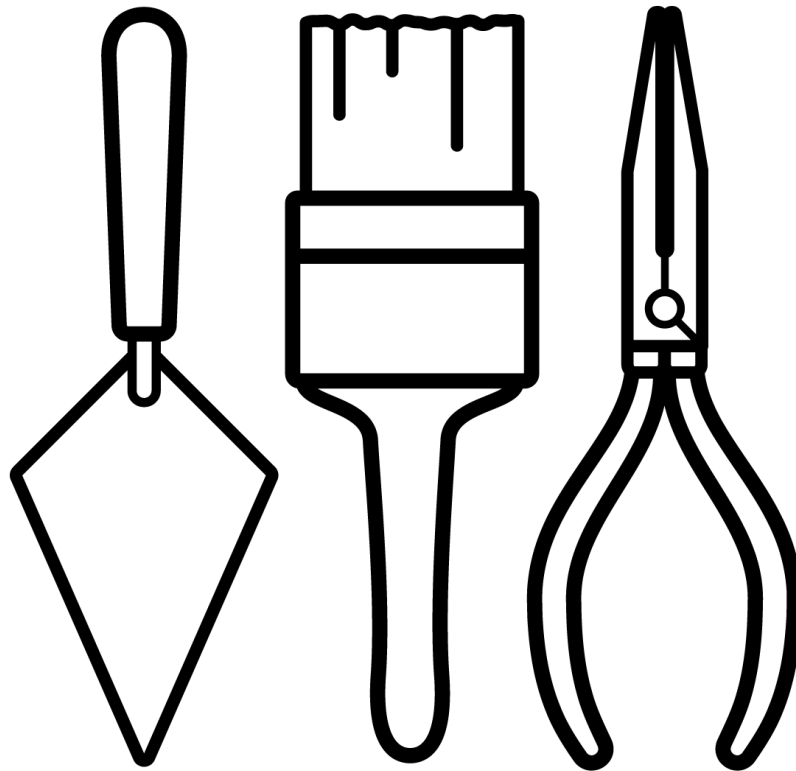

This assessment is about identifying BCATS trades required to build a residential building (e.g. a house).

You need to show you can create a comprehensive summary of the different trades involved, their roles, sequence, and how they can have an impact on each other.

You will need to provide the following evidence to support this. Submit it using myBCITO or the process at your school/organisation.



A copy of your summary.

The grade you are awarded will be based on your ability to thoroughly describe the different BCATS trades required to build a residential building.

Create a summary of BCATS trades required to build a house

The construction of a residential building involves four main stages.

- > Foundations.
- > Putting up the structure.
- > Making sure it is weathertight.
- > Finishing.

For this assessment activity, you need to create a summary of the different BCATS trades that contribute to the four stages above. You will need to include all of the following.

- The work each trade would do (e.g. the painter provides finishing to the interior and protection of areas while it dries).
- The order in which each trade comes in to do their work and how they can have an impact on each other (e.g. the plasterer prepares the internal walls before the painter comes in; if this takes longer than expected, it pushes out the completion date for the build).

You should present your summary in a format as agreed with your teacher.



Provide a copy of your summary as evidence.
